NATIONAL NUTRITION DAY

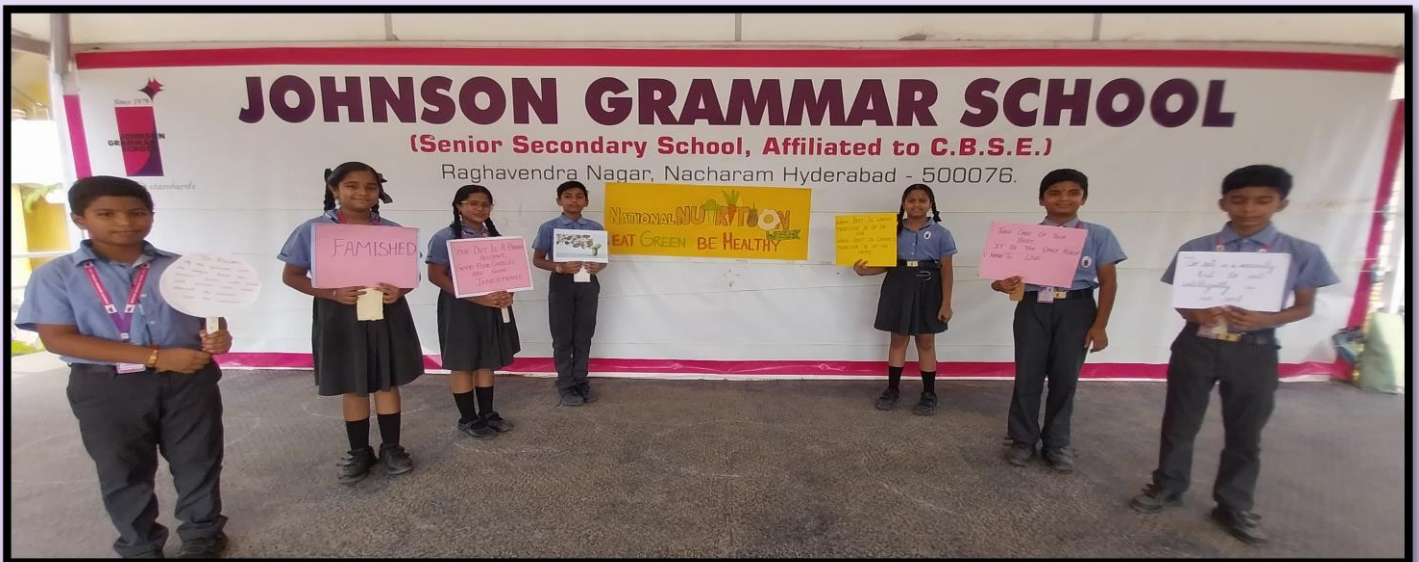
Eat healthy, be nutrition wealthy.

Students gave a presentation about the positive impact of eating healthy food. Healthy food helps to build our immunity. They have also brought the awareness how junk food affects our body through the presentation.

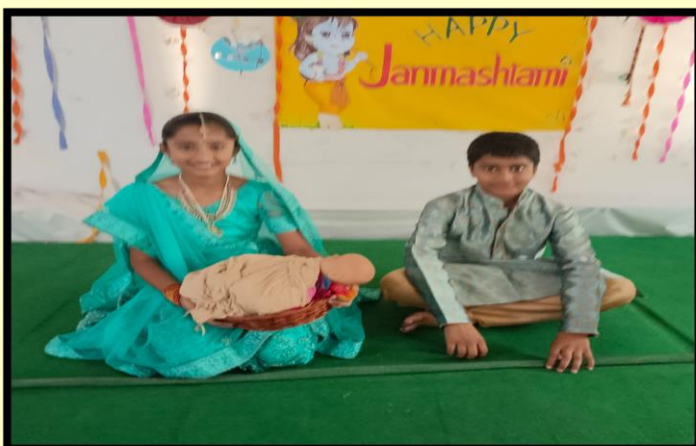
It really made the students to understand the importance of nutrition and the ill effects of junk food.

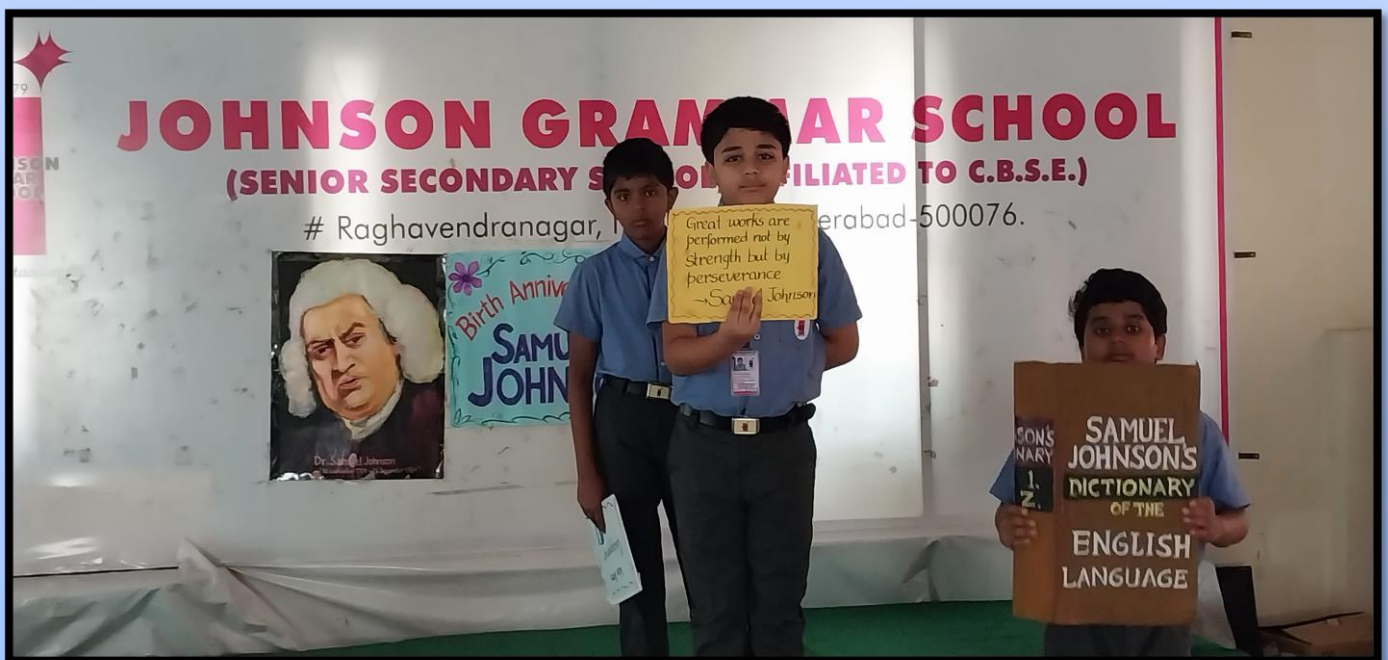
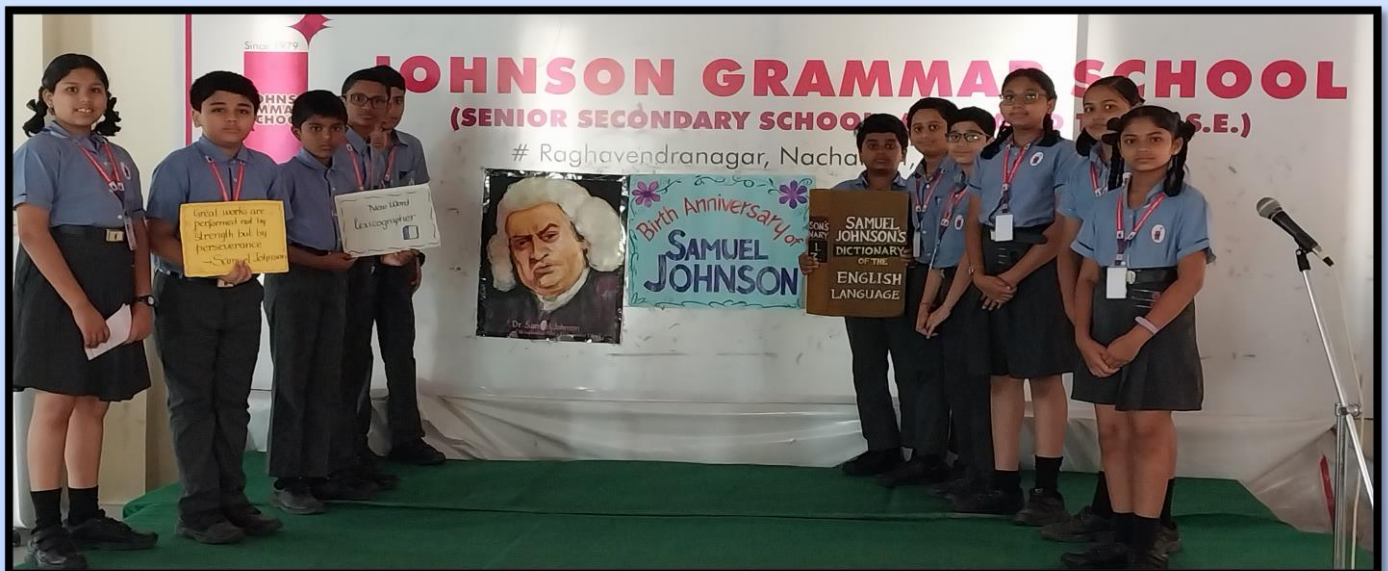
Dr. SAMUEL JOHNSON BIRTH ANNIVERSARY
