## THE QUIZ CONTEST !!

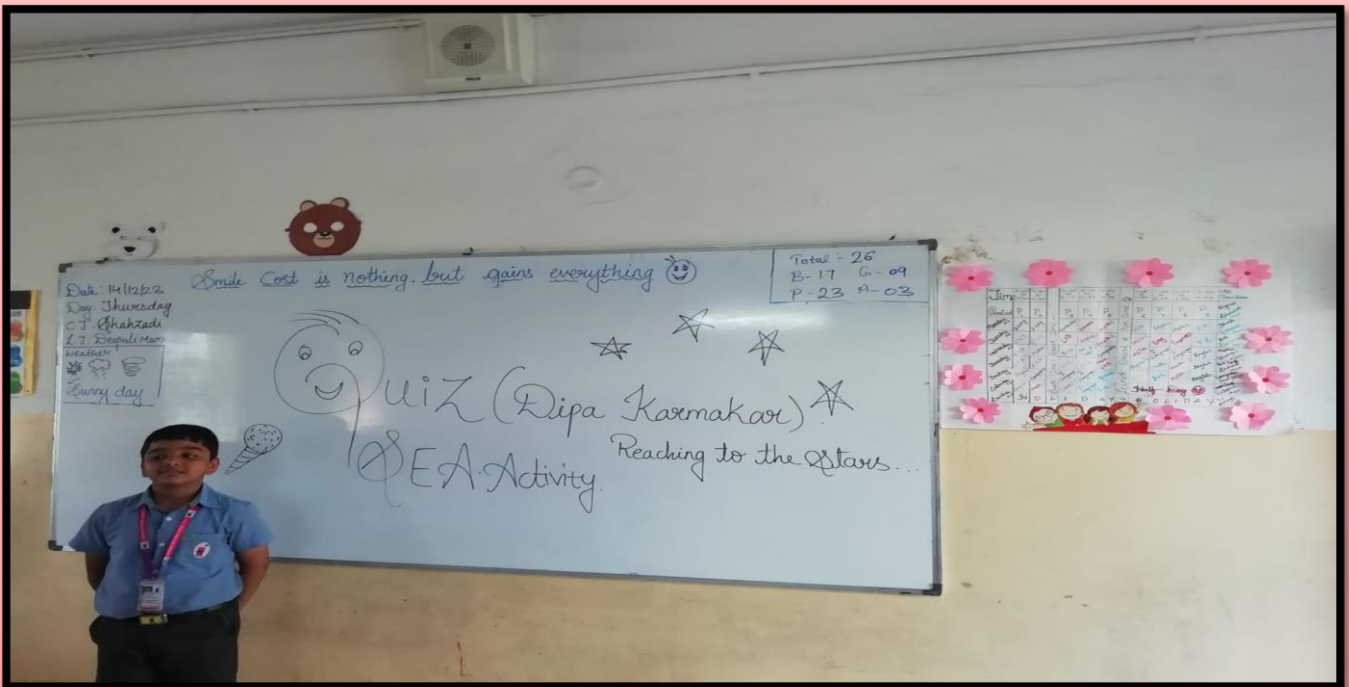
**“The true measure of intelligence is not how much you know but how well you can apply the knowledge in a Quiz Competition”**

“There is no friend as loyal as a book.”

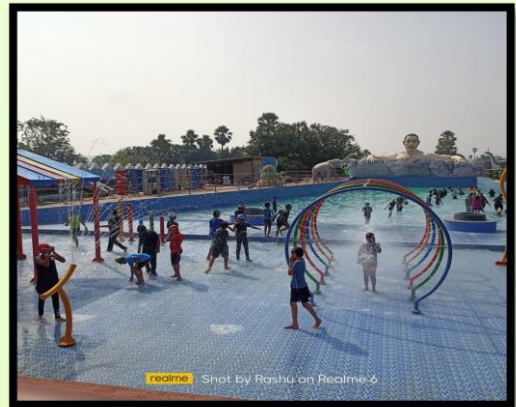
