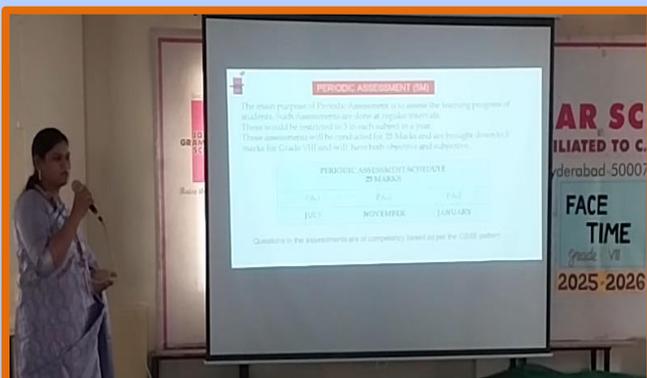
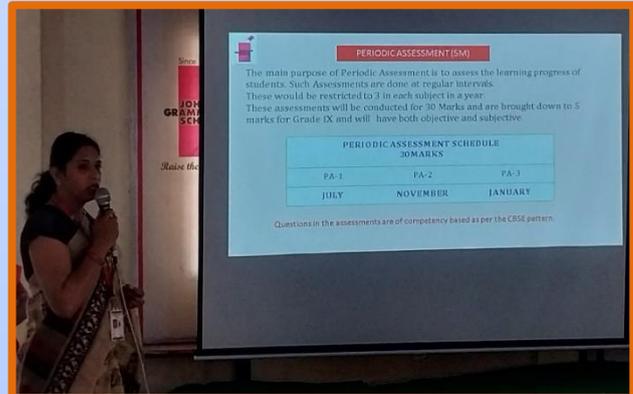


## Together We Achieve: Academic Orientation for Grades VIII-X

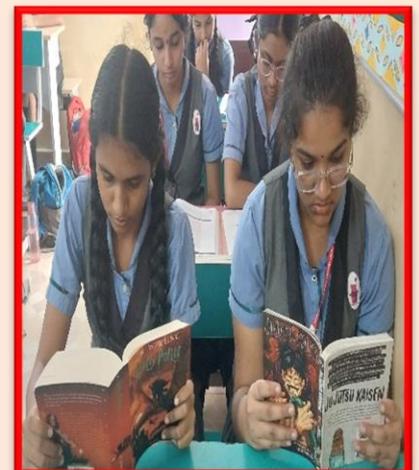


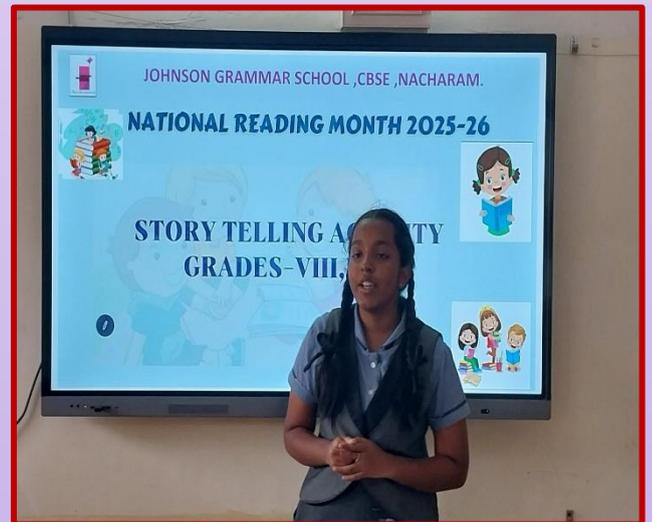
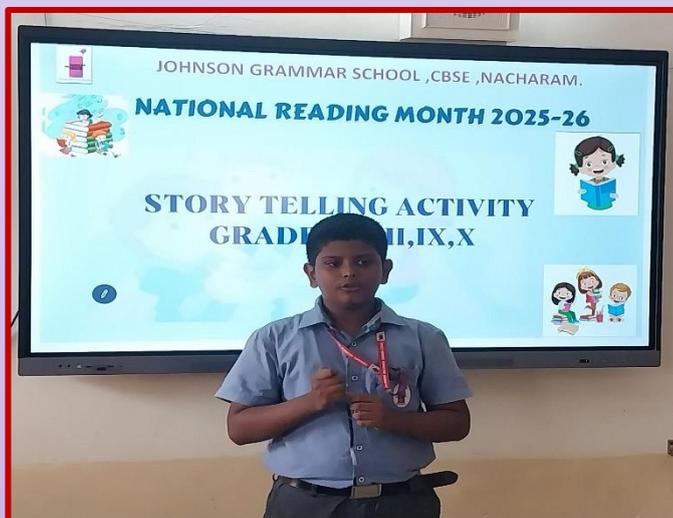
## NATIONAL READING DAY

- **Grade X** ventured into the imaginative realm of **Dreamscape – The World Beyond Reality**, capturing surreal and thought-provoking visions.

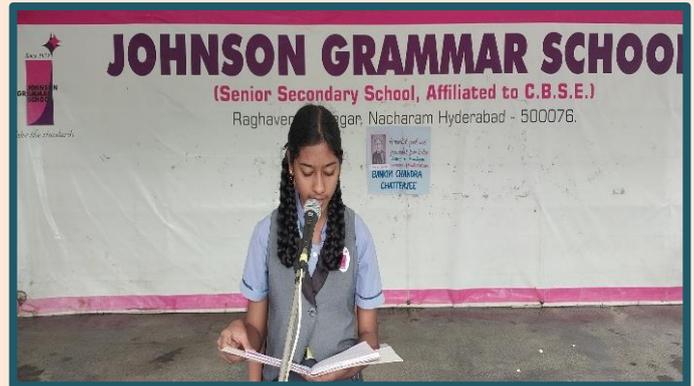
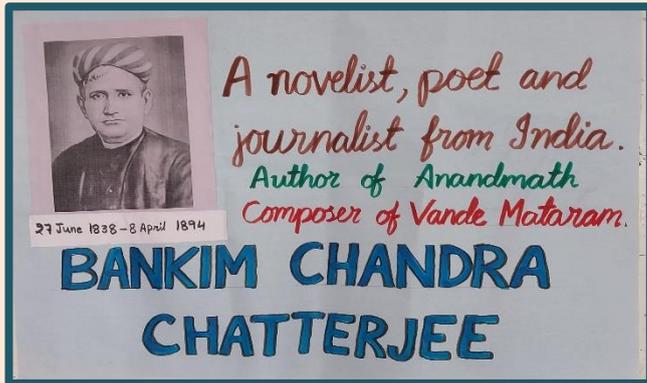
More than just a competition, the event was a celebration of creativity and student voice. In every brushstroke and shade, students reminded us that imagination holds the power to shape a better world.

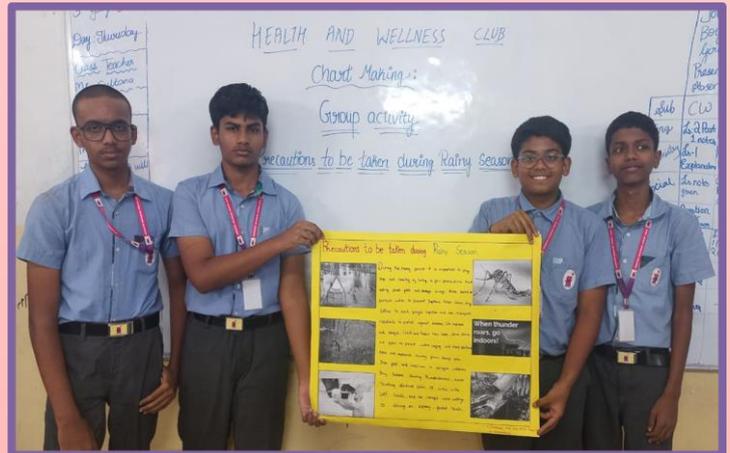
## Clubs in Action: Igniting Creativity, Collaboration, and Purpose

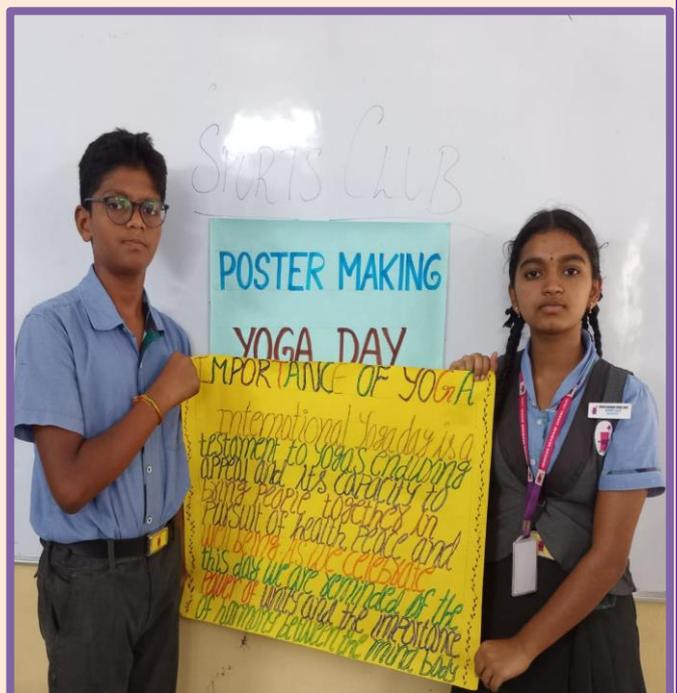
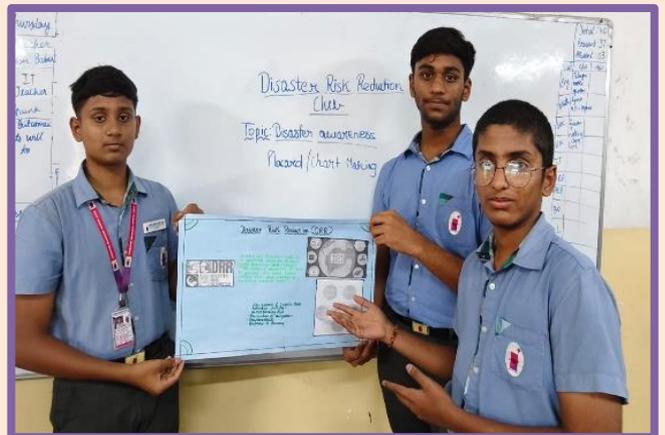

And credit my strength through the years.

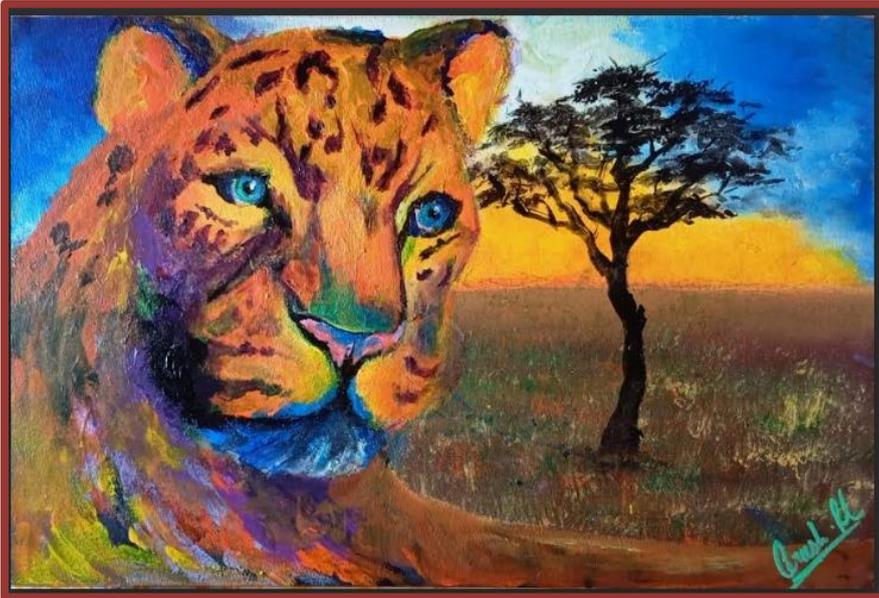
You fear you've dulled the light in me,

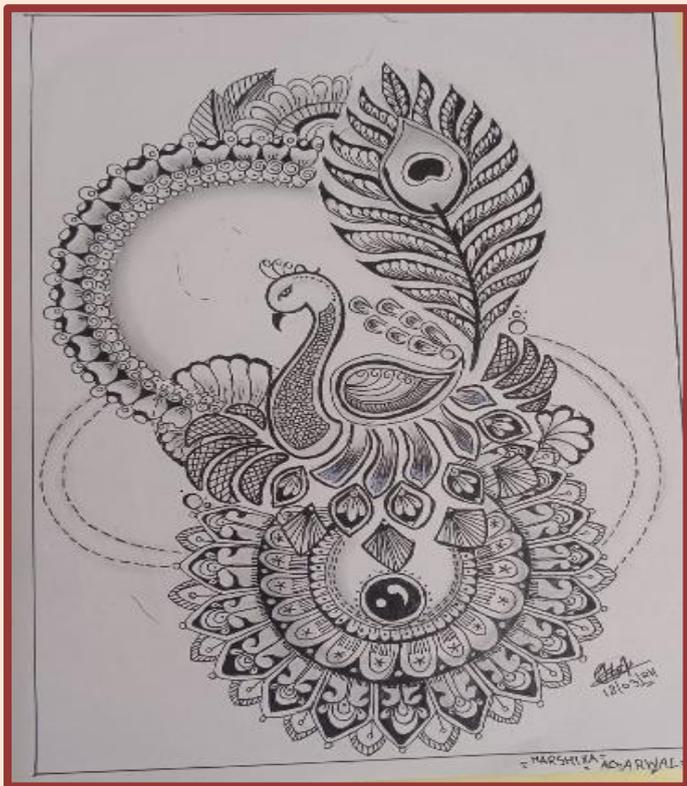

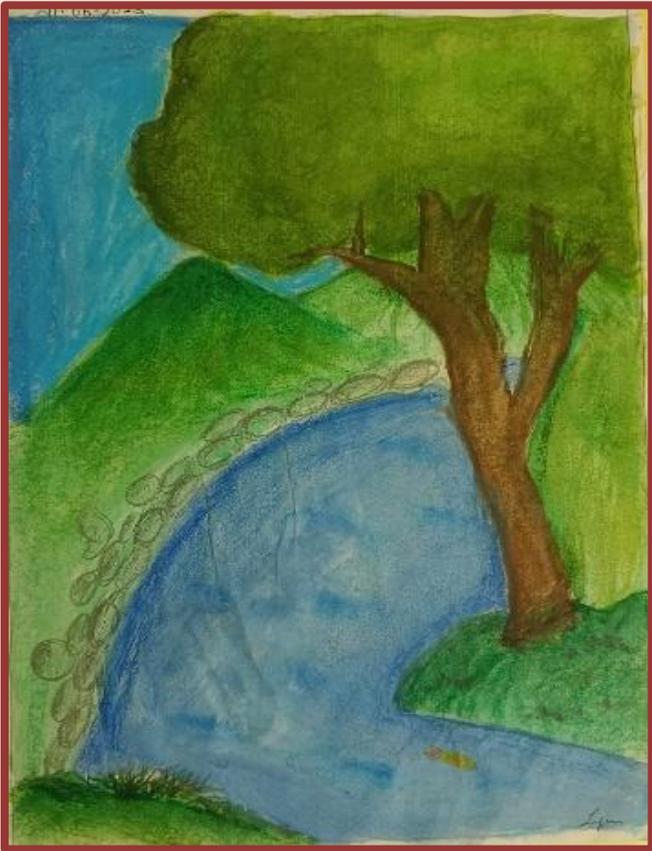
