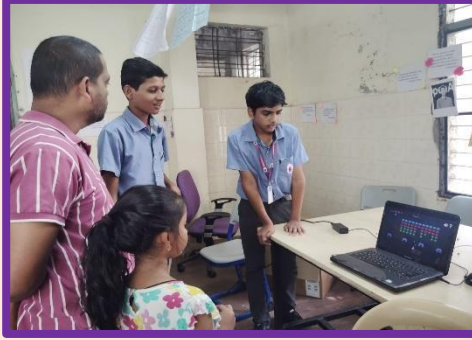

Young Innovators Shine at CBSE Regional Science Exhibition 2025-26

With the inspiring vision of STEM for Viksit and Atmanirbhar Bharat, our students showcased exceptional creativity and scientific thinking at the CBSE Regional Science Exhibition 2025-26, held on 6th and 7th November 2025. Representing the school with distinction, Master M. Ruthvik Reddy (Grade X) and Master Challa Harshith (Grade IX) presented their project “WattWay” under the sub-theme Emerging Technologies (Category II). Their innovative concept – enabling electric vehicles to charge while in motion – demonstrated a powerful commitment to sustainable innovation. 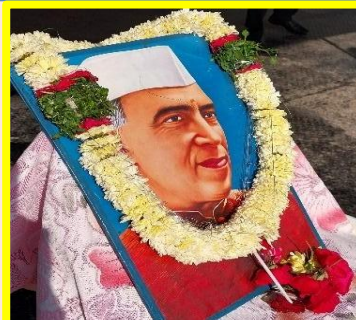


Children's Day Celebration - A Day of Joy, Love, and Inspiration
