

**A PAPER BAG- ACTIVITY**


**“Protect nature, and nature will protect you.”**

## MAGIC WAND TO A BETTER WORLD "Kind thoughts create magical actions."








## RANGOLI AND KITE MAKING ACTIVITY



## MATHS IS THE FOUNDATION


### When Maths Meets Real Life Learning Perimeter and Area

## SOCIAL HANDS-ON LEARNING "Exploring Transport Through Creative Booklets"


