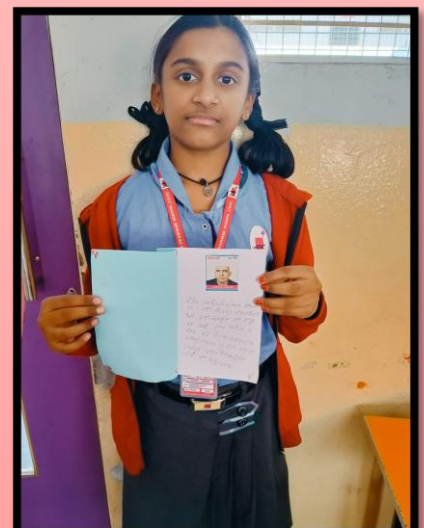
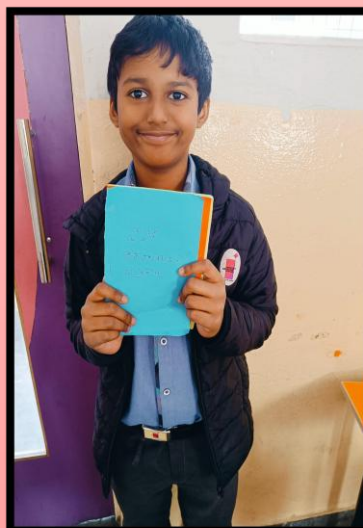
By following road safety rules, we protect ourselves and others.
