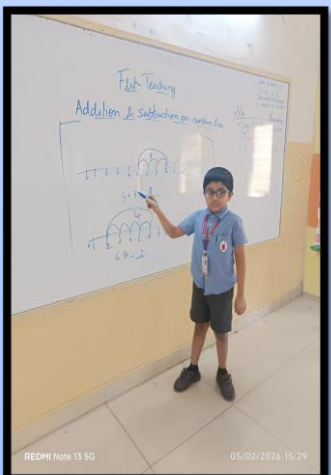
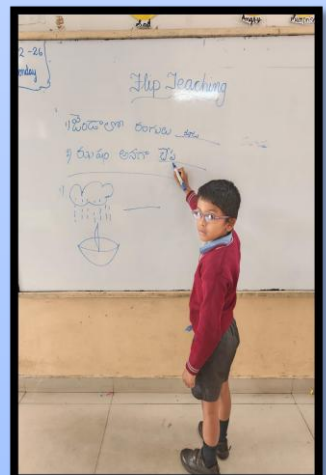
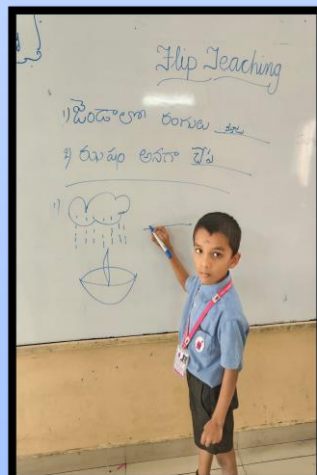
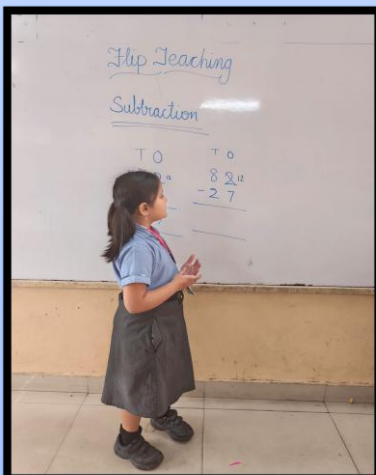
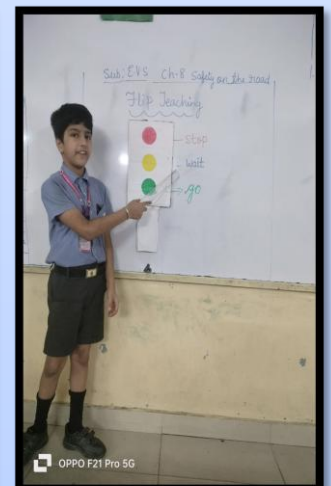
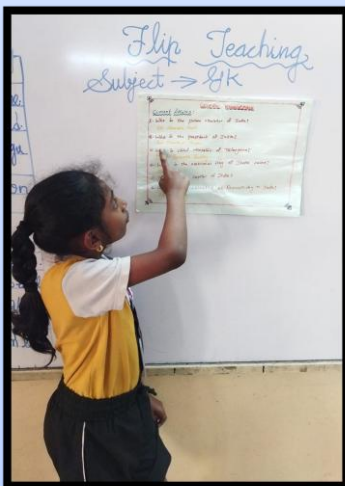


FLIP TEACHING
