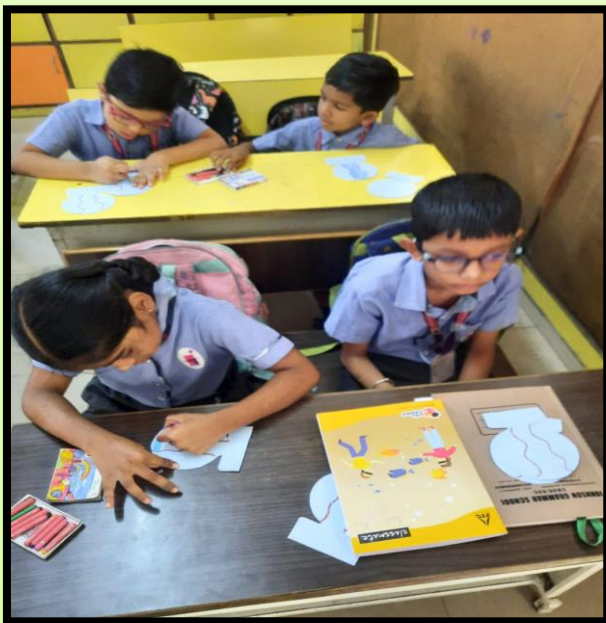


EARTH DAY ACTIVITY
