

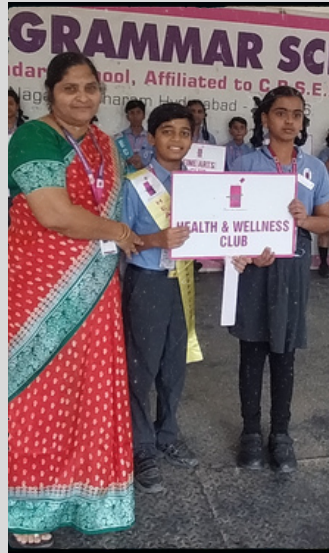


Junior Investiture Ceremony

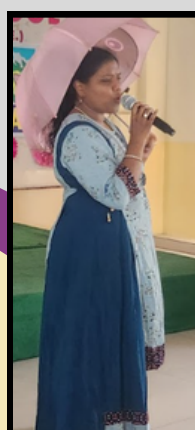
Inception Day & World Environment Day Celebration
